UNICEF states in its report that there are 168 million children aged 5-17 involved in child labour worldwide, and out of these, approximately 120 million are involved in hazardous work. Child labour refers to the employment of children under certain allowable conditions and restrictions that differ from country to country.

All our Cadets actively participated in the above lecture.

The biggest takeaway for our cadets from the above lecture was, as a citizen it is our duty to help eradicate child labour from the world.

Mr. Shebuel beno Moses organized free eye screening test in association with Narayana nethralaya rajaji nagar Bangalore.


Dr. Aditya. C patil and Dr.komal S ophthalmologist, Guided regarding 'eye care'.

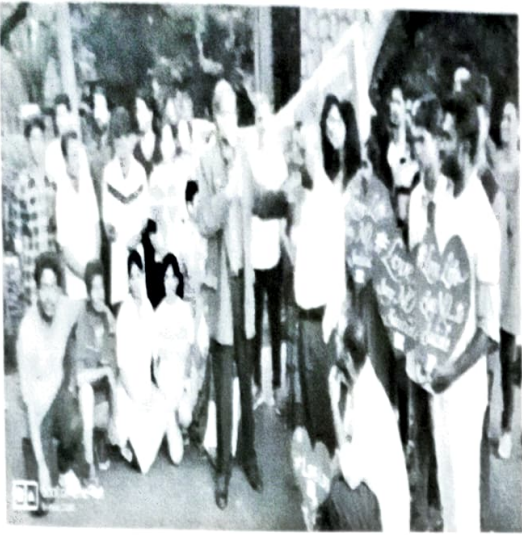

HEARTATHON DAY





