IQAC REPORT

Vivekananda Degree College is a reputed College in Bangalore city and was established in 1982. It is a co-educational institute offering five UG Programmes. The College offers both Government Aided and Management funded programmes. The College is recognized under 2(f) and 12(b) of UGC. The College was affiliated to Bangalore University since its inception. After trifurcation, institute is now affiliated to Bengaluru City University.

The institute has conducted orientation programme in the beginning of every academic year for newly admitted students to make them familiar to faculty and the College working style. The orientation programme is conducted for B.Com students on 1st day of reopening and for B.Sc. & B.A students on 2nd day of reopening. In this programme, Principal welcomed the students and staffs present. The faculty has made self-introduction to the newly admitted students. The students are also informed about various programmes that are being conducting in the College and the other physical facilities available in the institute. At the end Vice-Principal has proposed vote of thanks.

IQAC has prepared Time-table and academic calendar of the College before the commencement of the classes. In the 1st IQAC meeting, the strategies are made to conduct events and activities listed in the academic calendar. In subsequent meetings, the compliances of the previous minutes of meeting is reviewed. IQAC is reconstituted whenever it is necessary.

IQAC has informed all the Departments to conduct a Workshop/Seminar and the proposal for the same is received and it is ensured that these are executed to maximum possibility. Every department has prepared lesson plan in the beginning of the academic calendar and same is followed strictly.

The Institute has conducted two Internal tests apart from the University examinations for all the programmes as a part of continuous internal evaluation. The marks scored in the tests are communicated to the parents and parents of poor performed students are informed to attend parent's teachers meetings which are conducted after internal tests. Special classes /Remedial classes are conducted for poor performed students/slow learners to train them perform better in the successive tests and examinations.

IQAC has encouraged and inspired the newly appointed faculty to involve in the research activities by registering for Ph.D programme and publishing the research papers. College has spacious Library with sufficient books and E-Library facilities.
