Vivekananda Degree College: A Legacy of Growth and Excellence

Established in June 1982 by the Janatha Education Society (JES), Vivekananda Degree College embarked on its journey with a modest intake of 150 students across B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com. programs, supported by eight faculty members and two administrative staff. The college's steady progress was fueled by generous contributions from JES members, leading to remarkable growth. By 1986-87, the college served 700 students with a faculty of 15, necessitating infrastructure expansion, including new buildings and fully equipped laboratories. In 1987, following the non-grant period, the college secured Grant-in-Aid status from the Government of Karnataka, strengthening its foundation for future advancement. Achieving UGC recognition under sections 2(f) in 1991 and 12(B) in 1994 enabled the college to further its development.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Vivekananda Degree College, affiliated with Bangalore City University (BCU), has since played a critical role in advancing educational quality and institutional improvements. The college has provided avenues for learning with good infrastructure and library. The College offers 243 UG courses as per the syllabi of NEP and CBCS. The College offers many Certificate Courses, Skill Development Programmes to the students under Placement Cell and various Departments to become competent enough for their future career. The academic year 2022-2023 was enrolled with 293 students for UG and the total number of outgoing final year students is 243 and total Number of students during the year is 880 with 42 Teaching staff.

The College organized Induction Programme for the students at the beginning of the academic year 2022-2023 and oriented both students and parents regarding the introduction of NEP. During the academic year 2022-2023, faculty members have joined the institution. The faculty members have published articles and have attended Faculty Development Programme, Professional Development Programmes, workshops etc. The institution has signed several MoUs with academy and institutions. All the departments association has been inaugurated for the academic year 2022-2023 and conducted various programmes on teaching and learning process.

- The college achieved around 65 placements across multiple companies and organizations.
- Students received 06 awards and medals in cultural and sports events.
